


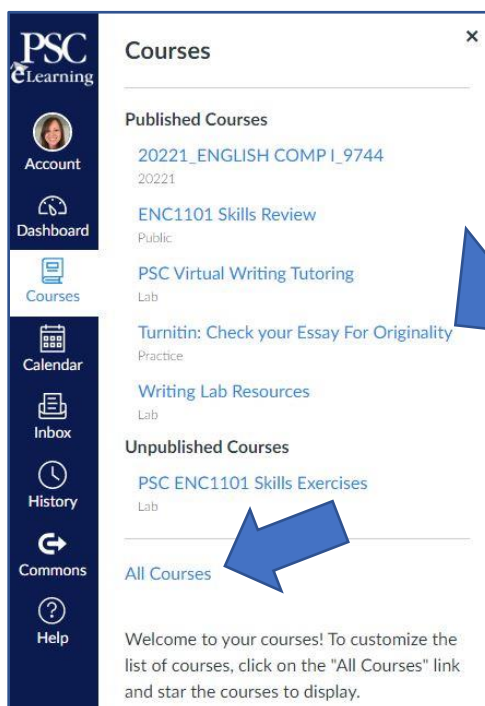
How to check your paper for plagiarism using TurnItIn

1. [Fill out this form](#) (shown below) requesting access to the TurnItIn self-check tool in Canvas.

3. Click on the TurnItIn Self Check 1 link on the course's homepage to upload your paper.

Turnitin: Check Your Essay for Originality

This site provides you an opportunity to check your paper for originality and grammar **before** submitting it to your course. Once submitted, a similarity report will be generated to help you identify if your documents are plagiarism-free. This report is only available to you as there is no instructor in this course. Your submitted papers will not receive a grade nor be stored in the Turnitin paper repository.
